What is a DiscipleNow Weekend?

DNOW is an in-town weekend retreat that allows students in Junior High and High School come together to worship, fellowship, and grow closer to Christ. This camp allows students to detach from the world, for a weekend, to focus on God and His Will for our lives. When is DNOW?

What is a host home? Who will be leading my child in small groups?

Host homes are where students stay during DNOW. Our hosts are people within our church that love Jesus and love teenagers. Our group leaders are hand-picked college students from all over Louisiana that have sacrificed their weekend to disciple our kids.
