### **Justin's Positional Statement:**

- 1. First, the Bible is trustworthy because it is God's divine revelation of truth given to man that leads to salvation. By the truth found in the Bible we may know God through a saving relationship with Jesus Christ. A truth that is given by God which leads to salvation is intuitively one that can be trusted.
- 2. Second, the Bible is trustworthy because it is inerrant, which means it is also infallible, or trustworthy.
